Scholarship opportunities for Russian exchange students to Umeå University

For Autumn term 2017, Russian students admitted within the North2North exchange programme for studies studies at Umeå University in Sweden, will be eligible for scholarships awarded by the County Administrative Board of Västerbotten.

The scholarship covers living expenses of 9000 SEK per month for a full term. Up to 5 scholarships are available. Students admitted to Umeå University within the North2North programme will be considered automatically for the scholarship. The selections are based on academic merit and made by the County Board. Selected students receive the scholarship upon arrival.

This scholarship programme was an initiative by the former County Governor Lorentz Andersson, with the goal of increased higher education collaboration with Russian partners especially those within the Barents region.

International Office at Umeå University will administer the scholarship.
